### Clinical Social Worker at Gulf Coast Health Care, FL

May 2022 - Present

- I successfully advocated for a client who was facing eviction and helped them to secure housing.
- I provided counseling services to an individual who had been sexually assaulted and helped them to recover from the trauma.
- I worked with a family in crisis and was able to help them resolve their conflict without having to involve outside agencies.
- I developed and implemented a treatment plan for a client with severe depression which resulted in the client no longer meeting criteria for diagnosis.
- I facilitated group therapy sessions on topics such as grief, addiction recovery, and domestic violence.

### Social Worker at Suncoast Hospice, FL

Sep 2019 - Mar 2022

- Negotiated with school district administrators to implement an Individualized Education Program (IEP) for a student with Autism, which resulted in the student receiving necessary services and making progress in their academics.
- Led a support group for parents of children with special needs that met weekly over the course of 6 months, resulting in increased knowledge and confidence among participants around advocating for their child's needs.
- Developed and implemented a therapy program for survivors of domestic violence that addressed both individual trauma as well as relationship dynamics, which improved communication skills and overall functioning for participating couples.
- Wrote successful grant proposals totaling \$250,000 over 2 years to fund mental health services for low-income residents in rural areas.
- Trained new social work interns on best practices around working with clients who have experienced trauma.
