Sep 2021 - Mar 2022

- Streamlined the process for conducting hearing screenings for newborns, which resulted in a decrease in the number of infants referred for further testing by 30%.
- Implemented a new method for tracking patients' progress and responses to treatment, which improved documentation accuracy by 25%.
- Led a team of audiologists in developing and implementing best practices for providing services to children with cochlear implants, resulting in an increase in satisfaction ratings from parents from 65% to 95%.
- Increased patient referrals by 15% through building relationships with local ENT physicians and pediatricians.
- Demonstrated expertise in counseling patients and families on coping strategies related to hearing loss, as evidenced by positive feedback from 91% of surveyed patients.
- Authored an article on advances in hearing therapy that was published in the leading professional journal.
