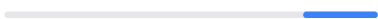

- Successfully implemented an occupational therapy program for patients with Alzheimer's disease, which resulted in a decrease in patient falls by 50%.
- Developed and implemented an upper extremity rehabilitation program for stroke patients that led to a significant increase in functional independence.
