EMPLOYMENT HISTORY

● Physician at Alaska Native Medical Center, AK

Mar 2022 - Present

- Led a team of 5 physicians and 20 support staff in providing care for over 2,500 patients per year.
- Achieved a 98% patient satisfaction rating.
- Reduced the average length of stay by 10%.
- Implemented an EMR system that increased efficiency by 25%.
- Authored 3 peer-reviewed articles.

● Assistant Physician at The Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium, AK

Sep 2018 - Feb 2022

- Led a team of 5 physicians in providing care to 200 patients per day on average.
- Supervised the implementation of new EHR system and trained 15 staff members on its use.
- Successfully managed chronic disease for 100% of patient panel.
