## EMPLOYMENT HISTORY

### ● Second Officer at Allstate, VT

Mar 2022 - Present

- Successfully piloted a 747-400 from London to New York during a severe winter storm, landing the plane safely despite near whiteout conditions.
- Worked with the Captain and First Officer to develop and implement new Standard Operating Procedures for the airline, which resulted in a 5% increase in efficiency.
- Successfully navigated the aircraft through airspace restrictions due to a terrorist threat, rerouting the flight while maintaining communication with Air Traffic Control.
- Conducted emergency landings twice in one month due to engine failure; no injuries or fatalities occurred as a result of either incident.
- Led team of 10 Flight Attendants during international flights lasting up to 12 hours; ensured passenger safety and comfort at all times.
- Maintained high customer satisfaction scores throughout tenure as Second Officer.

### ● Associate Second Officer at State Farm, VT

Aug 2019 - Feb 2022

- Successfully piloted a 747-400 during heavy turbulence and safely landed the plane at JFK.
- Successfully completed emergency landing procedures after engine failure on a 737-800.
- Worked with team of 4 other second officers to successfully land an A380 in strong crosswinds.
- Became certified as a Type Rating Instructor for the Boeing 777 family of aircraft.
- Type rating is necessary to operate certain types of commercial planes. As an instructor, was responsible for teaching new pilots how to fly these types of aircraft.
- Was part of crew that set new world record for longest nonstop flight by flying from Singapore to New York City – a distance of 18,534 kilometers (11,621 miles). The flight took off on November 9th and arrived back in New York City on November 10th – making it officially the longest flight ever flown!.
