I am a Youth Development Specialist with over three years' experience working with at-risk youth in an after-school program. I have a passion for helping young people reach their full potential, and my skills include curriculum development, program management, and community outreach.

In my previous role as Program Coordinator for the XYZ After-School Program, I was responsible for developing and implementing educational and enrichment programming for 80 students ranging in age from 6 to 18. I also oversaw a team of 20 part-time staff members, managed budgets totaling \$200K per year, and cultivated relationships with key partners including school administrators, local businesses, and government agencies. As a result of my efforts, student enrollment increased by 25% over two years while truancy rates decreased by 15%.
